### Notes To The Director:

The key to a successful performance of "A Baker's Tale" is to be sensitive to its ironic mix of humor and sentiment. This means keeping the up-tempo sections of the piece moving and playing the slower movements with unrestrained expressiveness.

The first movement ("The Baker's March") requires a precise, metronomic beat along with tight staccato articulations. Do not drag. Pay particular attention to the notated note durations, accents and dynamic markings. For example, in the first two measures, there is a sudden change in dynamics from *forte* to *piano*, whereas, unless the downbeat in measure two is very short, the off-beat figures will be obscured. This is also true of the trumpet solo (measure 5) and clarinet solo (measure 9). Take special note of the *sforzando* markings in the accompanying figures in measure 5 as well. The sixteenth-note figures in the trumpet and trombone sections at measure 31 must be played very soft and *staccato* so as not to take away from the flute and oboe lines above. These instructions really apply to the movement as a whole, since similar figures occur throughout.

The second movement ("Meditations Upon Spiritual Growth") begins with a long, expressive alto saxophone solo. The indicated metronome marking of 96 is merely an approximation. It should be played *molto rubato*, and the soloist given great leeway. Note that in measure 3, the A# and C# carry, but the G is natural. Be sure to exaggerate and bring out the trombone glissandos in measures 20-22.

As indicated in the score, the faster section, beginning in measure 24, should be precise and lightly articulated. Keep the accompanying sixteenths in the clarinets and bassoons from overpowering the solo oboe.

The lyrical section beginning at measure 49, again should be played in tempo and not allowed to drag. Make it sing. By contrast, the klezmer-like "brass band" in measures 57-69 should be tight and snappy. After a reprise of the lyrical section in measures 70-79, the movement returns to the style of the earlier faster section.

The third movement ("Hymn to the Celestial Village") is pure song. Make it flowing and lyrical. The accompanying eighth-note bassoon figures starting in measure 16 should be smooth and unobtrusive in order to give the music its forward motion. Pay close attention to the pyramiding chordal figures in measures 53-54 (bassoons and clarinets), 57-58 (trombones, bassoons and clarinets), 90-91 (saxophones, clarinets, basses, trombones and horns), and measure 95 (bassoons and clarinets). Each entrance of a "pyramiding" instrument should be accented in order to highlight the effect.

Resist the temptation in the final movement ("Denouement") to rush the tempo. Everybody likes a rousing finale, but pushing the tempo too hard will affect the sixteenth and triplet figures from measures 113-124. The fermata on the solo trumpet note in measure 141 requires particular attention because it precedes the final two measures which must be in tempo and together. Again, throughout "A Baker's Tale," rhythmic precision is the key.
